After Approval - Orientation, Introduction, Red Badge Committee and Committee Participation

A short meeting at the Gordon House is required for all new members. The new member will be asked to provide a bio, picture and initiation fee. After this meeting, all new members are publicly introduced to the entire Rotary Club at a Wednesday meeting. To assist new members learn about Rotary, they will be required to participate on the Red Badge Committee (which meets monthly) for one year with other new members. All new San Jose Rotary Members are required to join at least one additional committee within the first six months.
